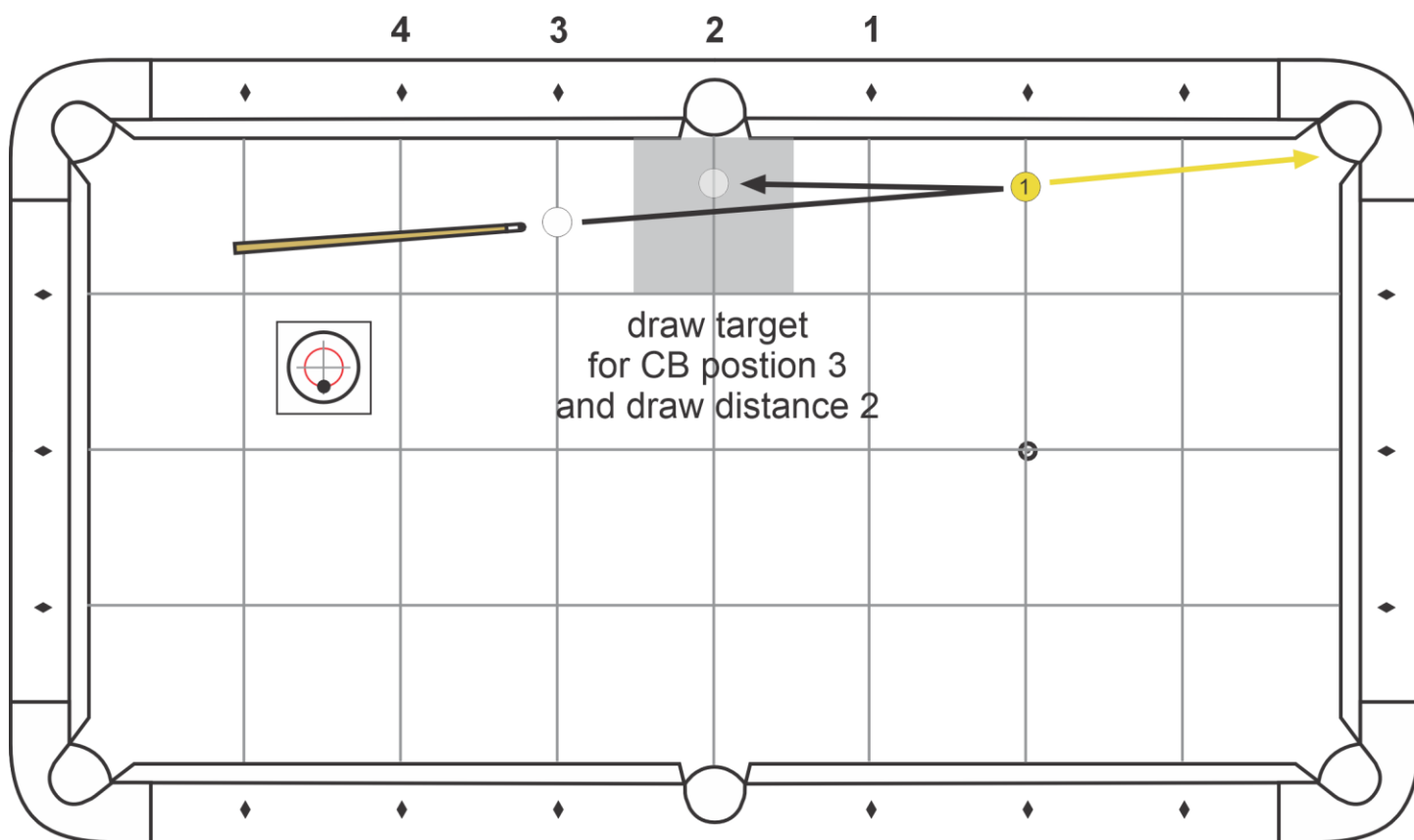


BU Exam VII – Draw Matrix Drill



Instructions:

- Pocket the OB and draw the CB back from **four different CB-OB distances (1-4 diamonds) to four different draw distances (1-4 diamonds)**.
- Take **three shots at each CB position and draw distance**, with each successful shot worth 1 point.
- Place the CB and OB anywhere you want along the diamond lines within one diamond of the side rail, with the **OB on the foot string** for all shots.
- You must **draw back so the center of CB is within a ½ diamond of the target distance**.
- The CB can come off the side rail, but the center of the **CB must remain within one diamond of the side rail**.

Total Score (max: 100) =

of successful shots (max: 48) x 25/12 (factor to scale max score to 100)
